

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT TO CORRECT DESCRIPTIONS.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 1st day of July,  
1919, between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting for  
this purpose by the Secretary of the Interior, under the  
provisions of the Act of Congress of June 17, 1902 (32  
Stat. 388) and acts supplementary thereto and amendatory  
thereof, known as the Reclamation Laws; and the NEW YORK  
CANAL CO., LTD., a corporation organized under the laws  
of the State of Idaho.

WHEREAS, under that certain agreement dated July 1,  
1918, between the United States and the New York Canal  
Co., Ltd., recorded on the 4th day of January, 1919, in  
Book 9 of Contracts at pages 159 to 176, in the office of  
the County Recorder of Ada County, Idaho, certain errors  
in description were made in the descriptions of lands  
shown in the Order and Certificate and list of lands at-  
tached to said contract, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties to correct  
the said errors of description.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between  
the parties hereto, that the certificate and list of  
lands attached to this supplemental agreement is given  
and accepted in lieu of the certificate and list attached  
to the said contract of July 1, 1918, and shall take the

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place thereof in so far as there may be any difference  
in the descriptions, number of shares and irrigable acreage  
between the said original list of lands and the list hereto  
attached.
